(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): At Jharsuguda Airport, the number of ATC officers has been increased from one in the year 2018 to five in the year 2019 and the present strength of ATC officers is sufficient to meet the current demand.

(c) & (d): Number of shifts is decided based on requirement of flight schedules of the airport and current traffic at Jharsuguda Airport does not require three shifts.
