Disposal of Urban Solid Waste

3086. SHRI SUMEDHANAND SARASWATI:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether instructions have been issued by the Government to the State Governments for developing infrastructure for disposal of urban solid waste, water treatment, plastic waste as per the environmental laws;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the State Governments have sought financial assistance for the purpose; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the financial assistance provided to the States for the purpose, State/UT-wise?

(a) to (d) The Ministry has comprehensively revised all waste management Rules, including solid and plastic waste management rules in the year 2016. The Rules, along with the mandate of various Ministries, Departments, Urban Local Bodies, Gram Panchayat, prescribe criteria for setting up of solid waste processing and treatment facility, waste to energy process, site selection etc. Further, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has issued guidelines for collection, categorization, transportation and disposal of solid waste.

MoHUA is implementing the Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) (SBM-U) project under which various projects have been taken up. Under this programme during the mission period of 2014-15 to 2019-20, an allocation of Rs. 7424.24 Cr has been made for Solid Waste Management Projects, which also include plastic waste. An amount of Rs 5024.45 Cr has been released to the State Governments till November, 2019.

The details of financial assistance provided to the States for the purpose is enclosed as Annexure A
