- (a) whether the Government has asked the Kendriya and Navodaya Vidyalayas of Gopalganj district of Bihar to fill up the vacancies quickly;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is fact that the Kendriya and Navodaya Vidyalayas of Gopalganj district of Bihar are running with teachers on contract basis to meet the shortage of teachers;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the details about teachers strength in these schools?

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Both Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) and Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS) have been advised from time to time to review their vacancy position and take action for filling up the vacancies as per the provisions of the relevant Recruitment Rules of the posts.
- (c) to (e) As informed by KVS and NVS, the vacancy position of teaching staff in the Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV), Gopalganj and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV), Gopalganj along with the details of teachers engaged on contract basis are as under:
