Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that some anti-social elements in Assam are banning the sale of clothes manufactured in Mubarakpur in Azamgarh of Uttar Pradesh, the leading area in handloom sector;
- (b) if so, the action taken against the said anti-social elements involved in unconstitutional activities; and
- (c) whether keeping in view the interests of the weavers of the said area the Government proposes to promote the sale of their handloom products in other States also including Assam?

- (a): As per report received from the Government of Assam, some organizations of Sualkuchi, Assam have insisted for stopping the sale of Mulberry Silk Assamese Mekhela-Chadar pairs made in Varanasi, Mubarakpur and Azamgarh, Uttar Pradesh, where some orders are placed by the local traders.
- **(b):** The Directorate of Handloom & Textiles, Government of Assam, has intimated it to be a case of trade rivalry and have pacified the same by conducting awareness campaign and involving the civil administration.
- (c): Government of India has been providing marketing facilities all across the country including State of Assam under Handloom Marketing Assistance (HMA), a component of National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP). Since 2016-17, a total of 678 Handloom Marketing events/expos have been organized in different states to help weavers from all across the country to sell their products.
