Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount earmarked for setting up new family planning centres during the current five year plan, especially in the backward and rural areas of the country as on date;
- (b) whether the financial target fixed in this regard during the last three years have been achieved; and
- (c) if so, the details of the financial target fixed and family planning centres opened, State/UT-wise particularly those of backward and rural areas?

(a) to (c): Under the National Health Mission, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare follows a health systems approach wherein stand alone family planning centres are not established. Family Planning services are delivered as an integral component of the RMNCAH+N strategy (Reproductive Maternal Neonatal Child and Adolescent Health + Nutrition) through all levels of public health facilities across the country.
