- (b) the number of beneficiaries who availed treatment under CGHS in Rajasthan during the last five years, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open new dispensaries/wellness centres under Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) in the districts having more than 1000 beneficiaries; and
- (d) if so, the time by which these are likely to be opened along with the details thereof?
