- (a): Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for people engaged in Fishery Sector is being undertaken under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and State funded skill programmes.
- (b): The total No. of trainees enrolled for RPL by various affiliated Training Providers is as under;
