- (b) if so, the details thereof; and

- (a) and (b): NCERT has informed that the content related to the views and thoughts of great reformer Sree Narayana Guru has already been included in NCERT textbook "Our Pasts-III" for class VIII with a theme 'Women, Caste and Reform' under section on Caste and Social Reform. In this section under the sub heading Demand for Equality and Justice, there is a mention of Sree Narayana Guru alongwith his photograph. One of his famous statement is also mentioned in the Chapter i.e. "orujati, orumatam, orudaivammanushyanu" (one caste, one religion, one god for humankind).
