VACANCIES IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

3251. DR. UMESH G. JADHAV:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vacant posts in teaching staff (PGT, TGT and Special Educators) across Kendriya Vidyalayas across the country including Karnataka;
- (b) whether such vacancies have increased over the years and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has identified reasons behind the vacancies and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to ensure zero vacancy in schools; and
- (e) whether there have been any modifications to the recruitment procedure to maintain a good quality of teaching staff and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) As on 15.11.2019, details of sanctioned posts, staff in position and vacant posts of PGTs and TGTs in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) located all over the country are as under:-

Post	Sanctioned posts	Staff in positions	Vacant posts
PGT	10812	9869	943
TGT	16686	14876	1810

There are no sanctioned posts of Special Educators in the KVs.

(b) to (d) Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and action is taken from time to time as per the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules for filling up of the posts. As the process of filling up vacancies involves various methods of recruitment

such as promotion, Limited Departmental Examination, Direct Recruitment etc. takes time, teachers are also engaged on contractual basis for temporary duration by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered. Directions have also been issued to autonomous organizations including Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan from time to time for reviewing their vacancies and for taking prompt action for filling up of vacant posts in the vidyalayas.

(e) No, Sir. KVS always adopts a fair and transparent procedure in recruitment in order to maintain good quality of teaching in its schools.
