3323: SHRI L.S. TEJASVI SURYA:

Will the Minister of **FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of State-wise data of the number of stalled projects that will be provided funding from the Alternative Investment Fund proposed to be created;
- (b) the number of stalled projects eligible for funding in major cities viz. NCR-New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, and Chennai; and
- (c) whether Rs. 10000 crore proposed expenditure from the Government will be over the Budgeted Expenditure for the present financial year and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (FINANCE) (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

- (a) to (b): As per the study commissioned by the Investment Manager of the first AIF/Fund under the Special Window for affordable and middle-income housing viz SBICAP Venture Limited, 2,202 housing projects in the affordable and mid-income segment comprising approximately 4.58 lakh launched units are stalled (including NPA/NCLT projects). A Statement indicating details of stalled projects in major cities is at **Annexure.** Funding will be provided by the AIFs under the Special Window if the project meets certain criteria such as: -
 - (i) Net-worth positive
 - (ii) Affordable and middle-income housing projects
 - (iii) On-going projects registered with RERA
 - (iv) Reference by existing lender
- (c): The total commitment of funds to be infused by the Government in the affordable and middle-income group housing sector through the AIFs under the Special Window would be up to INR 10,000 crores, which will be released through appropriate budget allocations on the basis of drawdown notices received from the investment manager.
