(a) to (d) National Skill Development Agency (NSDA) has undertaken various activities viz. anchoring and operationalizing competency based National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF); maintaining National Qualifications Register (NQR), a repository of all approved qualifications; developing a National Quality Assurance Framework (NQAF); creating and maintaining a dynamic Labour Market Information System etc. So far more than 3500 qualifications packs have been approved by the NSDA.

Training under all the skill development programs implemented by various Central Ministries/Departments are to be aligned to the NSQF for maintaining quality and standards.
