- (a) whether abrogation of Article 370 affected tourist flow in Kashmir;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the comparison of tourists visited during the last four months with the last five years;
- (c) whether the Government plans to bring tourism back on track; and
- (d) the number of tourists visited Kashmir during the last 30 days?

(a), (b) and (d): The number of tourists visiting Kashmir from August to November during last five years are as under:
