## **ANSWER**

(a) to (c): In order to facilitate Police in States/ UTs with a common platform for filing reports, collecting and sharing information on crimes and criminals at national level, the Ministry of Home Affairs has implemented the Crime and Criminal Tracking and Network Systems (CCTNS). Search facility on the national database of CCTNS data has been made available to various investigating agencies.
