SHG IN RAJASTHAN

3545. COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Self Help Groups (SHGs) in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) the number of women who have found employment via SHGs in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (c) whether SHGs have been established in all districts of Rajasthan and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether any additional layer of activities/responsibilities related to health, nutrition, etc. have been added to SHG's in the country and Rajasthan in particular if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the estimated timeframe for the SHGs in the country and Rajasthan in particular, to become self-sustainable and self-reliant?

ANSWER

(a): There are a total of 150438 Self Help Groups formed in Rajasthan under Rajeevika till November, 2019. The details of numbers of SHGs district wise is provided in the **Annexure -1**.

(b): As per information provided by Government of Rajasthan, 333489 women have found direct/indirect employment through SHGs in Rajasthan. The district wise list of SHG members who found employment through SHGs is provided in **Annexure -2**.

(c): **Yes Sir.** SHGs have been promoted in all districts of Rajasthan under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM).

(d): **Yes Sir.** The State Rural Livelihood Missions (SRLMs) of all states have initiated integration of Food, Nutrition, Health and WASH (FNHW) within the programme activities with a focus on diet diversity, reducing anemia, menstrual hygiene, diarrhea and health & nutrition care of elderly & differently abled etc. Hand wash practices, usage of toilets and management of waste are also being promoted through SRLMs.

In Rajasthan, during the “Poshan month” celebrated in September 2019, the SHGs in the State have participated very actively in the activities like hand washing demonstration, rallies, Jan Andolan, setting up of food stalls etc across all 33 districts of Rajasthan.

(e): The main strategy of DAY-NRLM is to build strong self-reliant institution of Women SHGs. The SHGs are provided financial support of Rs.10,000 to Rs.15,000 per SHG as Revolving Fund(RF) and upto Rs.2.50 lakh per SHG as Community Investment Fund (CIF). Providing continuous capacity building support to the SHGs is the integral part of the programme. Funds received by SHGs are managed by these organizations on their own.
