ATTACKS OF MAOISTS

359. SHRI N. K. PREMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has conducted any study regarding the attacks of Maoist in various parts of the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether attacks of Maoist were reported in Kerala during the last five years;

(d) if so, the details of attacks reported along with the death or injury reported in Kerala due to the attacks of Maoist during the last three years;

(e) whether any case has registered against Maoist during the last three years in Kerala;

(f) if so, the details thereof;

(g) whether encounters between Maoist and police were reported from Kerala during the last three years; and

(h) if so, the number of Maoist and police personnel died and injured in the Maoist attacks and encounters during the last three years?

(a) & (b): No Sir. The MHA has not conducted any study related to 'Attacks of Maoists' in various parts of country.
