Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any decision to construct new railway line between Yadgir (Karnataka)-Khammam (Telangana) via Narayanpet, Mahabubnagar, Jadcherla, Kalwakurthy, Devarakonda, Nalgonda and Suryapet;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the required funds have been released for this railway line and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the present status of this railway line; and
- (e) the time-limit fixed for its completion?
