- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to divert any train from Chennai to Trivandrum via Madurai, Sengottai, Punalur in order to decongest the existing heavily loaded train route via Kadpadi, Salem, Coimbatore;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a)to(c) No, Sir. Diversion of train running from Chennai to Thiruvananthapuram Central via Katpadi- Salem- Coimbatore instead of Madurai- Sengottai- Punalur is operationally not feasible, at present, due to single line section between Madurai and Virudunagar.
