- (b) if so, the details thereof and the details of the basic infrastructure provided in Delhi, Rajasthan and Haryana;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to extend this facility to the companies operated by it; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

The standards for IMT 2020 (International Mobile Telecommunications 2020), also known as 5G technologies in industry, are being finalized. After finalisation of IMT 2020 standards, question of providing infrastructure for 5G network will arise.
