(a) and (b) Yes Sir. Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development has launched the **National Educational Alliance for Technology** (NEAT) scheme for using technology for better learning outcomes in Higher Education. The Scheme uses Artificial Intelligence (AI) to make learning more personalized and customized as per the requirements of the learner. All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has been designated as the Implementation Agency for NEAT. One of the mandates for AICTE while implementing NEAT is that, AICTE would ensure that the solutions are made freely available to a large number of the socially and economically backward students.
