- (a) Total seventeen districts namely, Ranchi, Lohardaga, Latehar, Palamau, Garhwa, Simdega, Gumla, Khunti, Ramgarh, Bokaro, Saraikela–Kharsawan, East Singhbhum, Kodarma, Hazaribagh, Godda, Dumka and Sahibganj are connected with National Highways under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Jharkhand.
- (b) to (d) Total 8 nos. of works with an aggregate length of 343 km having cost of about Rs. 6531.00 crore have been sanctioned and awarded till date under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Jharkhand.
