CONSTRUCTION OF RING ROAD AROUND AMRITSAR UNDER BHARATMALA

4023. SHRI GURJEET SINGH AUJLA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct ring road around the city of Amritsar under the Bharatmala Pariyojana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, whether the Government has any plans to include the city of Amritsar in next stages of Bharatmala Pariyojana; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d) Government of India had approved Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I in October, 2017 for development of highway stretches with an aggregate length of about 34,800 km (including 10,000 km residual NHDP stretches) at an estimated outlay of Rs. 5,35,000.00 crores. In Bharatmala Pariyojana, total 28 nos. of Ring Roads as well as 191 nos. of choke points/congestion points have been identified for development in the country including provision of intervention (01 no. bypass) at Amritsar in the State of Punjab.
