EXPANSION OF SALEM AIRPORT

(a) whether the Government has begun the land acquisition for expansion of the Salem Airport, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Government has any plan to utilise the unused 1500 acres

land of Salem Steel Plant; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

Minister of State (IC) in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (स्वतंत्र प्रधार) (Shri Hardeep Singh Puri)

(a): Generally, land for airport projects is provided by concerned State Government/Union Territory (UT) Administration to Airports Authority of India (AAI) free of cost and free from all encumbrances. For development/expansion of Salem Airport, AAI has projected a land requirement of 446 acre to the State Government of Tamil Nadu. (b): No, Sir. no such proposal is under consideration in Ministry of Civil Aviation/AAI at present.

(c): Does not arise.
