EMPLOYMENT FOR URBAN POOR

NO. 4074. SHRIMATI PRATIMA MONDAL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING & URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain schemes are being implemented to provide employment to the urban poor in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;**
- (b) the amount of funds sanctioned, released, actual expenditure made and the targets achieved including the number of persons given employment, State/UT-wise; and**
- (c) whether the Government proposes to expand the scope of the said schemes and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE
MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)**

- (a) The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), since 2014-15, to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. The Employment through Skill Training & Placement (EST&P) component of the Mission aims to provide skills to the urban poor to increase their income through structured and market-oriented**

certified courses that can provide wage employment and/or self-employment opportunities which will eventually lead to better living standards and alleviation of urban poverty on a sustainable basis. Further, Self-Employment Programme (SEP) component focuses on financial assistance to individuals/groups/SHGs of urban poor for setting up gainful self-employment ventures or micro-enterprises.

- (b) The funds are released to States/UTs for implementation of Mission as a whole and *inter-se* allocation of funds under various component are made by the State Governments depending upon their requirement and capacity. A statement showing State/UT-wise details of funds released by Government and utilised by States/UTs under Mission, during FY-2014-15 to 2019-20 (as on 31.10.2019) is at Annexure-I.**

A statement showing details of physical progress of States/UTs under Mission during FY 2014-15 to 2019-20 (as on 31.10.2019) is at Annexure-II.

- (c) The Mission has been extended to all statutory towns in the country since February, 2016.**
