- (a) the details of new National Highway sanctioned for construction in the State of West Bengal(WB);
- (b) whether the Government has received any proposal for construction of new NH from Pursura to Deulti Bagnan in Uluberia (WB);
- (c) if so, the action taken thereon; and
- (d) the funds allocated and released for development and construction of NHs in WB during the last three years?

- (a) 677 km length of new National Highways (NHs) has been declared in West Bengal since 2014-15.
- (b) & (c) Ministry has not received any such proposal from Government of West Bengal for construction of new National Highways from Pursura to Deulti Bagnan in Uluberia (WB).
- (d) Funds allocated & expenditure incurred for development and construction of NHs in West Bengal during the last three years are as under.
