#### **Lake Beautification Projects**

#### 4155. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is undertaking any lake beautification projects across the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the details of such projects, their locations and stipulated time of completion of such projects, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh?

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) & (b) Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) is currently implementing a centrally sponsored scheme namely, National Plan for Conservation of Aquatic Eco-systems (NPCA) for conservation and management of wetlands including lakes in the country on cost sharing basis between Central Government and respective State Governments. The scheme covers various activities such as interception, diversion and treatment of wastewater, shoreline protection, lake front development, in-situ cleaning i.e. desilting & deweeding, storm water management, bioremediation, catchment area treatment, Lake Beautification, survey & demarcation, bio-fencing, fisheries development, weed control, biodiversity conservation, education and awareness creation, community participation, etc. Proposals received from the States under the scheme are considered for financial assistance subject to their conformity with the scheme guidelines, prioritization, appraisal by independent institutions, recommendations of State Level Steering Committees/ State Wetlands Authorities and availability of Plan funds.

The details of projects sanctioned for conservation and management of lakes under the scheme of NPCA are given in the Annexure.
