SMART ANGANWADIS IN KERALA

4176. DR. SHASHI THAROOR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the relevant information on Integrated Child Development Services and Anganwadi;
- (b) the current total number of non-functional Anganwadi Kendras in India, State/UTwise;
- (c) the steps being taken to make them functional;
- (d) the detailed information on the 'Smart Anganwadi Project';
- (e) whether Thiruvananthapuram has been chosen to host first "smart" Anganwadi in State of Kerala; and
- (f) if so, the details of financial assistance towards the said project and the projected developments in the Kendra?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) The Anganwadi Services (earlier known as Integrated Child Development Services scheme) is a unique programme for early childhood care and development. It offers a package of six services, viz. Supplementary Nutrition, Pre-School Non-Formal Education, Nutrition and Health Education, Immunization, Health Check-Up and Referral Services. The beneficiaries under the Scheme are children in the age group of 0-6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers. The objectives of the scheme are to improve the nutritional and health status of children in the age-group of 0-6 years; to lay the foundation for proper psychological, physical and social development of the child; to reduce the incidence of mortality, morbidity, malnutrition and school dropouts; to achieve effective co-ordination of policy and implementation amongst the various departments to promote child development; and to enhance the capability of the mother to look after the normal health and nutritional needs of the child through proper nutrition and health education. These services are delivered through 13.77 lakh operational Anganwadi Centres. At present, there are 836.25 lakh beneficiaries availing these services as on 30.06.2019.
- (b) State-wise statement indicating the number of sanctioned, operational and non-operational Anganwadi Centres across the country is at **Annexure-I**.
- (c) This Ministry has been writing to States/UTs from time to time to operationalise the non-operational AWCs. They have been advised to re-assess their requirement of Anganwadi Centres (AWCs). States/UTs have also been authorized on 1st December, 2014 to relocate AWCs after taking into consideration the conditions stipulated therein.
- (d) to (f) As per the information received, for the overall physical and mental development of children, Government of Kerala intends to construct Anganwadi Buildings as Smart Anganwadi; the first being in Thiruvananthapuram District at Poojappura, with better amenities for children. The State Government has designed six types of plans for Smart Anganwadi Buildings on the basis of the availability of land. It has provision for Class Rooms, Dining Hall, Kitchen, Store Room, Creative Zone, Indoor and Outdoor Play area. The State Government has sanctioned Rs. 44.94 lakh for constructing the first Smart Anganwadi in Thiruvananthapuram District.
