- (a) & (b): Registrar General of India has provided estimates on Maternal Mortality Ratio using the Sample Registration System (SRS) for 19 states of India in the recent report of SRS 2015-17.

The details of the maternal mortality ratio State/UT- wise during 2014-16 and 2015-17 is placed at annexure A.

- (c) The details of States/UTs who have achieved National Health Policy target of MMR 100 per lakh live births well ahead of 2020 is placed at annexure B.
