- (b) if so, the number of cases related to Rajasthan that have been forwarded to various agencies of Rajasthan Government/ ACB by the CBI during the last three years, casewise; and
- (c) the provisions for seeking monitoring/investigation reports from the concerned States with regard to the cases forwarded by CBI along with the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Yes Sir,

A total of 830 complaints related to Rajasthan have been forwarded to various agencies of Government of Rajasthan by CBI during the last three years, i.e. 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 (upto 31.10.2019) for taking necessary action at their end.

The year-wise breakup for the last 3 years is as under:
