- (c) whether the Railways proposes to conduct recruitment drives to fill the backlog;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of number of vacancies including technical, non-technical, safety related posts in the Railways as on date, post-wise, category-wise, group-wise and zone-wise separately; and
- (f) the time by which these posts are lying vacant along with the reasons therefor?

(c) & (d) Recruitment process in Railways is being done regularly through authorized recruiting agencies namely Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) and Railway Recruitment Cells (RRCs). The shortfall or backlog vacancies of SCs, STs, and OBCs left unfilled are taken care of in subsequent recruitment cycle.

(e) & (f) The staff strength position of Group 'C' and erstwhile Group 'D' on Indian Railways as on 01.04.2018 is appended. Sanctioned posts in all categories are more than the actual operational requirement as they also include an element of Leave Reserve and Rest Giver which varies from 12.5% to 30% in safety categories. Arising and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process in the Railways. The policy of the Government is to fill up the vacancies as per operational requirement.
