RAILWAY TICKETS IN DIFFERENT LANGUAGES

569. SHRI L. S. TEJASVI SURYA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the ministry will provide information in regional languages like Kannada, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Bengali, Gujarati etc., in the various websites of the Railways like irctc.co.in, indianrail.gov.in, rrbcdg.gov.in *in lieu* of the different languages spoken and practised in various parts of the country and the technological advances leading to easier design;

(b) if so, the deadline by which such information would be available;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) whether the Government is planning to introduce printing of railway tickets in regional languages, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF RAILWAYS AND COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) to (c) The website irctc.co.in, indianrail.gov.in and rrbcdg.gov.in are

bilingual i.e. English and Hindi. There is no plan to provide information on

these websites in regional languages, at present.

(d) Presently unreserved tickets are being printed in 7 regional languages viz. Kannada, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Gujarati, Marathi and Punjabi. The name of originating and destination station, class and train type is printed in regional languages on these tickets.
