REPLACEMENT OLD COACHES BY LHB COACHES

584. SHRI K. MURALEEDHARAN:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the trains originating from Kerala that have been converted to Linke Hofmann Busch (LHB) coaches;
(b) whether most of the long distance trains originating from Kerala are having dilapidated and refurbished coaches; and
(c) if so, the details thereof and the time bound action plan that has been initiated to replace these old coaches by LHB coaches?

ANSWER

(SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) Indian Railways do not run trains on State-wise basis as the rail network transcends state boundaries. As such conversion/ introduction of trains with LHB stock is also not undertaken on State-wise basis. However, 23 pairs of trains origination /terminating in the stations located in the State of Kerala are running with LHB coaches.

(b) Coaches deployed on trains running over Indian Railways including those serving Southern Railway, which caters to the State of Kerala, are within their respective codal life and fit for operation.

(c) With a view to provide safer and more comfortable journey to the travelling passengers, it has been decided to proliferate/induct modern Linke Hofmann Busch (LHB) coaches and convert trains operating with conventional coaches by LHB coaches, in a phased manner.

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
