SMALL SCALE INDUSTRY STATUS TO DYE MAKING INDUSTRY

818. SHRI RAJENDRA DHEDYA GAVIT:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government is likely to award small scale industry status to the ancient jewellery dye making business of Palghar district of Maharashtra which is quite popular among the tourists and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether any coordination has been set up with the Government of Maharashtra or any scheme is being formulated for awarding recognition to the jewellery dye making business as that of an industry and exploring a market for it under tourism and if so, the details thereof?

(a): Under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (MSMED Act, 2006), the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises have been classified as follows:-
