- (d) the quantum of funds already released under the said scheme?**

(a) to (d) : Government of India launched Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) in December, 2014, for extending financial assistance against capital expenditure to address gaps in the power sub transmission and distribution networks in urban areas.

The details of major works under IPDS, funds allocated, funds released and progress in the State of Assam, circle-wise are available as Annexure.

Apart from the above major works, Information Technology (IT), projects worth Rs 26.02 crore, Gas Insulated Substations (GIS) worth Rs. 19.76 crore; Real time data acquisition system (RT-DAS) works worth Rs 4.77 crore have also been sanctioned. Against IT projects, funds to the tune of Rs 1.49 crore have been released. GIS and RT-DAS works have been awarded.
