- (b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The Government is committed to the disinvestment of Air India. The Government approved a Plan for Air India which focused on, inter-alia, operational efficiency, increase in revenue, cost saving etc. as well as a comprehensive financial package. The financial support, inter-alia, included providing Government guarantee of Rs. 7600 crore to Air India Limited for raising new debt for payment of stretched liability for the FY 2018-19. Out of the Rs. 7600 crore guarantee provided to Air India, Air India raised Rs. 2500 crore from banks against this guarantee. Three loans have been drawn from NSSF in FY 2018-19 amounting to Rs. 2636 crore. Air India has sought Government guarantee for Rs. 1000 crore immediately, for raising funds from bank (this amount is within the limit of Rs. 7600 crore).
