- (a) whether the Government has taken any step towards four-laning of Kanpur-Bilhour-Kannauj –Etah-Bewar-Aligarh-Bulandshahr-Ghaziabad –Delhi G.T. road;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the funds spent on the maintenance and repair of the said stretch during each of the last three years?

(a) & (b) Yes Sir. The details of the project along with their present status are as below:

- (c) Ghaziabad –Aligarh section of National Highway (NH) has been developed on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) mode and maintenance of the stretch is the responsibility of Concessionaire at his own cost. However, funds spent on maintenance and repair of Aligarh –Kanpur Section of NH during 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 is Rs. 1.73 crore, Rs. 8.28 crore and Rs. Nil respectively.
