(a) to (d): The Department of School Education & Literacy was implementing the Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (CSSTE) till 2017-18. These schemes were reviewed and accordingly, an Integrated Scheme for School Education-Samagra Shiksha was launched from 2018-19 by subsuming SSA, RMSA and Teacher Education (TE).

Samagra Shiksha has provision for computer education for Classes VI to XII.

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
