(a) The number of National Highways (NHs) and State Highways in the state of Gujarat are 36 and 360 respectively.

(b), (c) & (d) 14 roads/Highways in the state of Gujarat have been declared as National Highways during last 3 year and current year. The development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. The works on NHs are, accordingly, taken up depending upon inter-se priority, traffic density and availability of funds. An amount of Rs. 516.14 crore has been spent on these newly declared National Highways.
