(a) to (e) The Budgetary allocation for Bharatmala Pariyojana including Residual National Highways Development Project (NHDP) during 2019-20 at proposed Revised Estimate (RE) stage has not been reduced; it has been kept at the same level as that of Budget Estimate (BE) stage. Head-wise details of allocations for NHAI during 2019-20 BE and proposed RE stages are as follows: -
