(a) to (e): Yes, Sir. Creation of an eco-system for voluntary phasing out of unfit and older polluting vehicles is under consideration. The objective is to reduce vehicular emission and consequent environmental pollution, as well as reduce fuel consumption through the phasing out of the unfit and polluting vehicles.
