(a) to (c): The Government has approved phase-III of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) with an aim to consolidate $1,25,000 \mathrm{~km}$ Through Routes and Major Rural Links connecting habitations, inter-alia to Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs), Higher Secondary Schools and Hospitals at an estimated cost of Rs 80,250 crore (Central Share- Rs. 53,800 crore, State Share- Rs. 26,450 crore). The State-wise allocation of Road length under PMGSY-III is as under:-
