- (d) the number of toilets constructed, repaired and functional in Andhra Pradesh during the last three years, year-wise and district-wise?

(a) and (b) In response to the announcement made by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 15 August, 2014, the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development had launched Swachh Vidyalaya initiative to provide separate toilets for girls and boys in all Government schools, within one year upto 15th August, 2015. Under the initiative, construction/re-construction of 4,17,796 toilets was completed in 2,61,400 Government elementary and secondary schools as reported by the States and UTs. State/UT-wise details are given at **Annexure-I.**

(c) As per UDISE 2017-18, district-wise number of schools, number of schools with functional toilets and dysfunctional toilets in Andhra Pradesh are given at **Annexure-II**.

(d) The district-wise numbers of toilets constructed in schools in Andhra Pradesh during the last three years are given at **Annexure-III.**
