- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 37 DUE FOR REPLY ON 4TH FEBRUARY, 2020.

(a) to (d): The Government of India has sanctioned 25 seed hub Centres across the country for increasing the availability of quality seeds of Nutri-Cereals (Millets) under the Project "Creation of Seed-Hubs for increasing Indigenous Production of Millets in India", which is being implemented by ICAR- Indian Institute of Millets Research (IIMR), Hyderabad. Out of the total outlay of Rs.964.10 lakhs under the National Food Security Mission (NFSM)-Nutri-Cereals, an amount of Rs.723.08 lakhs has been released during 2019-20 to IIMR, Hyderabad for seed hubs. For 19 out of these 25 centres, funds have been allocated for infrastructure development for seed processing, seed production and storage of seeds. Details of locations of these centres in different states along with funds allocated to each centre is annexed.

The remaining 6 centres located at UAS, Bengaluru, Karnataka; AlCRP Sorghum-MPKV Rahuri, Maharashtra; AlCRP Sorghum, PDKV, Akola, Maharashtra; VNMKV, Parbhani, Maharashtra; PTJSAU, Palem, Telangana; and OUAT, Berhampur, Odisha, which are already implementing seed hub programme for pulses / oilseeds, have been identified for quality seed production of Nutri-Cereals (Millets) also by utilizing existing infrastructure facilities under pulses / oilseeds.
