- (a) & (b): Presently, there are seven operational airports in Rajasthan. Out of these, four airports viz. Jaipur, Kishangarh, Kota and Udaipur are owned and operated by Airports Authority of India (AAI). The remaining three airports viz. Bikaner, Jaisalmer and Jodhpur are strategic airports owned by defense authorities where AAI maintains civil terminals.
- (c): The total footfall at these seven airports has increased from 52,24,640 in 2016-17 to 75,81,334 in the year 2018-19.
- (d): Airlines plan their domestic flight schedule on a specific route/cities based on market demand, commercial viability and their company policy. Further, during stakeholders discussions airlines are requested to mount flights from un-served airports.
