(a) Cabinet has approved setting up of new AIIMS in Bibinagar, Telangana at a cost of Rs.1028 crore. Approved timelines for completion of the project is September, 2022. Rs. 5 crore have been released so far to the Executing Agency.

(b) Funds are released to the Executing Agency/Procurement Support Agency (PSA) as per the progress of the project at appropriate time/milestones achieved as per MoA with these agencies. New AIIMS are being funded through the Higher Education Funding Agency(HEEA) and there is no problem of funds for any new AIIMS construction.
