101. SHRI A. RAJA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the National Employment Enhancement Mission;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under this Mission during the last three years and the current year across the country including Tamil Nadu;
- (c) the details of the number of students trained under this mission so far across the country including Tamil Nadu along with the number of students offered jobs;
- (d) whether the percentage of jobs offered is very low under this mission across the country;
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor and the action taken by the Government in this regard;
- (f) whether the scheme is not proving as per the expectations within the country; and
- (g) if so, the reasons therefor along with the steps taken/being taken by the Government to make it successful?

(a) to (g): The National Employability Enhancement Mission (NEEM) scheme was launched in 2013 by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to offer on the job practical training by the industry to enhance employability of person between the age of 16-40 years pursuing Post Graduation/ graduation / Diploma in any technical or non-technical stream or who may have discontinued studies after class 10th class. NEEM Scheme is not an employment guarantee scheme. The trainees are offered stipend by the industry concerned. No funds are released under this scheme. NEEM facilitators which are approved by AICTE provide National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) compliant industrial training. The training is provided for a period of 3 months to 36 months. Till date, 43 NEEM Facilitators and a total of around 4 lakh trainees have been enrolled by different NEEM Facilitators including in Tamil Nadu. More than 1, 60,000 trainees have been regularized / placed in their trainee company after the completion of their training under the Scheme.
