- c) the time by which the said institute is likely to be opened keeping in view the great need of employment, skill development and quality journalism;
- d) whether IIMC proposes to start courses in Bengali, Gujarati, Assamese, Maithili, Tamil, Kannada, Telugu, Punjabi, Nepali and Santhali; and
- e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

These campuses impart diploma courses in various Indian languages including Hindi, Urdu, Odia, Marathi and Malayalam. At present, there is no proposal to open more campuses of IIMC in other parts of the country.
