National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has recently constituted a technical committee including India Meteorological Department (IMD) to explore the technological options of low cost Lightning Arrester Solution in certain States including Maharashtra. This initiative is taken under the World Bank assisted National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP) Phase-II and the States of Goa, Gujarat, Kerala, Karnataka and West Bengal are also supposed to get benefitted from this initiative.
