2. Post-Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class XI onwards).
3. National Fellowship & Scholarship for Higher Education for ST students.
4. National Overseas Scholarship for ST students for studying abroad.
5. Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS).
6. Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)
7. Grant-in-aid to Voluntary organizations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes.
8. Scheme of Strengthening Education among ST Girls in Low Literacy Districts.
9. Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution.
10. Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) for the welfare and development of Scheduled Tribes.
