1191. SHRI UPENDRA SINGH RAWAT:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that large amount of funds allocated for primary schools, secondary and technical education, remained unutilised or re-appropriated in the Country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, scheme-wise and State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the reasons for diversion, non-appropriation and re-appropriation of such funds?

(a) to (c): The Department has launched the **Samagra Shiksha** – an Integrated Scheme for School Education by subsuming the erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE) from 2018-19. It is an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education.

Samagra Shiksha is one of the major Centrally Sponsored Schemes and the allocation of Budget and the release of central share of funds and also the contribution by the States towards their share (based on the sharing pattern) is regulated and governed by laid down procedures and conditions which requires strict compliance and therefore the funds have necessarily to be utilised only for specific sanctioned activities. Further, in built check in the form of Internal Audit, Statutory Audit and concurrent Audit is conducted so that the anomalies can be detected.
