- (e) if so, the details thereof, district-wise;

(a) to (g) Yes Sir, the Government of India has approved the proposal of setting up of Indian Institute of Skills (IISs) at three locations in the country at Kanpur (Uttar Pradesh), Mumbai (Maharashtra) and Ahmedabad (Gujarat) on **Not-for-profit Public Private Partnership** (N-PPP) basis. As of now, there is no proposal for setting up of IIS in Rajasthan.
